FRIDAY APRIL 11

III Scarlett Nominated for a 2008 Juno for New Group of the Year, the 4 member band from Mississauga, Ontario promise a set of fist-pumping ska, surf-punk, pop and reggae jams. Their second studio album, All Day With It, was shepherded by No Doubt's producer Mathew Wilder.



Rally Car The Vancouver boys horsepower-driven rock and roll hit mainstream radio listeners after winning the 99.3 FM The Fox Vancouver Seeds Contest competing with over 850 other bands for the coveted spot. Having toured across Canada regularly, the band has developed a dynamic live stage show.

SATURDAY APRIL 12

Lil' Jaz presented by **CDOSECA** Toronto native, Lil' Jaz, is one of Canada's most versatile DJ's. He has been gracing stages world-wide for over 12 years as a Turntablist, band DJ, and party rocker. Touring with Nelly Furtado and presently K-OS, Jaz has transcended the typical archetype of a band DJ, truly exemplifying the musicianship of a turntablist accompanying a band.



SATURDAY APRIL 12 | Big Air | 8pm

Ravidrums Straight from LA, Ravidrums offers his trademark explosive performance, remixing live on the drums and percussion, for a serious blast of sensory overload.



DJ Crooked a Korean/American born in Honolulu, Hawaii but raised in New York City, is something of a phenomenon and an overnight success, Crooked has been DJ'ing all his life but started taking it seriously in 2002 when he was approached to do a couple of weekly parties in the East Village of New York City. Since then, he's been DJing in New York for clubs like Marquee, Lotus, Cain, Home, PM, Pangaea, and Show as well as Jest East and Cain/Cabana in the Hamptons.

SUNDAY APRIL 13

The John Butler Trio Organic roots-rockers, the John Butler Trio have been hailed as Australia's answer to the Dave Matthews Band. Their fifth album, Grand National (2007) upped the ante after Sunrise Over Sea (2003) went five times platinum. The posterboys of indie success, they joined Bono and Eddie Vedder to Make Poverty History in 2006.



Mama's Cookin' Hip-hop beats and dirty Delta blues anchor the sound of Mama's Cookin'. Their self-titled 2007 release was hailed as an album that "hits like a ton of bricks wrapped in velvet" and was produced by award-winning producer Chuck Zwicky (Prince/Jeff Beck) along with special guests Maya Azucena (Stephen Marley), and producer Pete Miser (Dido).





MONDAY APRIL 14

Daniel Wesley The trio, singer/guitarist Daniel Wesley, bassist Pietro Marco Luongo and drummer Alex Glassford III hail from Vancouver, where they've been storming the West Coast music scene since forming in January 2007. A hybrid sound of beach, roots, reggae and rock that channels Sublime, the Red Hot Chili Peppers, Jack Johnson and Pearl Jam, their first single, "Ooo Ohh" became CFOX's most requested song of the year.

Current Swell Victoria, BC, based Current Swell have embraced their own style of music, incorporating a blend of rock, folk, reggae and blues to create their own unique sound. The band's experience includes 3 national tours, an Australian tour and performances with Bedouin Soundclash, The Beautiful Girls, IllScarlett and Xavier Rudd.



TUESDAY APRIL 15

Blue Scholars As momentous as 2007 was for Seattle's Blue Scholars, 2008 is already looking to be even bigger for the duo as they prepare to drop their second digital EP and third music video since the release of their critically acclaimed album Bayani on Massline/Rawkus. Since Bayani hit the streets in June 2007, Geologic and Sabzi have toured relentlessly, headlining sold-out shows up and down the West Coast and most recently touring with West Coast hip-hop legends Hieroglyphics and upcoming dates with GZA of Wu-Tang Clan.

Common Market formed unofficially and unintentionally during a collaborative project in 2004 when Sabzi (Saba Mohajerjasbi) contributed beats to RA Scion's Live & Learn. The two casually discussed the idea of releasing an EP based on their mutual respect for mid-nineties era east coast hip-hop, as well as a shared spiritual foundation in the Baha'i Faith; that project, recorded entirely in a week-long session inside a sweltering Beacon Hill attic, would become what now stands as the moniker for both the band and the album: Common Market.

Animal Nation A generous slather of irony, layers of sounds from jazz standards to pop-culture icons like the Sound of Music and Sesame Street, to rock and back to hip-hop, and an insomnia-fuelled debut album "Selfless Mind Indulgence". So tasty you'll be begging for more.

NOBODY REALLY West Coast hip-hop MC, NOBODYREALLY has been working the Whistler scene for more than five years steadily gaining a rep for top lyrics and street smarts.







Wednesday April 16

The Trews Originally from Antigonish, Nova Scotia, now based in Toronto, the rock purists' just released third album, 'No Time For Later', offers their heaviest, but most artistically coherent work yet. Reviews have hailed the "shrewd marriage of new and classic rock" for its appeal to every generation of rock aficionado.



Black Swade Hard Rockin' prodigies, Black Swade have taken the Pacific Northwest by storm with performances at last year's TWSSF, the World Cup mainstage and GMC Cup Canadian Ski Championships, since playing in Seattle's EMP "Sound Off" Underage Band Competition, all before completing senior high school.



Thursday April 17

Blackalicious Rolling Stone summed up the California-based hip-hop duo with Blackalicious' own lines: "passion, the drive to press, to strive for best," and "aural pleasure, y'all." Alt-rappers favouring the "positive tip", Xavier Mosley (Chief Xcel) and Tim Parker (Gift of Gab) came out of the Sacramento/Davis underground rap scene in 1991, and bring sonic depth, boombastic energy and 15 years of craft-mastery to the Main Stage.

Friday April 18

Julian Marley The youngest of Bob Marley's talented progeny, Julian Marley plays Whistler as his first Canadian concert ever, with a mix of original tunes from his solo albums Lion in the Morning (1996) and A Time and a Place (2003) and classic reggae anthems.

Flowmotion Heady rock and roll and a stellar rhythm section powers Flowmotion's mix of world-funk, jam-rock and sweet balladry. A staple of the Northwest indie music scene for their crowd-unifying, energy-infecting grooves.

Saturday April 19

Team Canada presented by **COSEC2** Originally a battle DJ, D.R. One linked with producer DJ Grandtheft in Montreal. Realizing they had a creative style of party-rocking DJing in common, the duo began throwing parties all over the east coast. Eventually they formed the Team Canada DJ Crew in late 2004 and released their all-remix whitelabel debut "Classic Material Volume 1". Team Canada have quickly established themselves as Canada's top club remixers and party DJs. Blazing some of the hottest clubs worldwide with a unique mix of music, they have made their mark with a four turntable party set. People who have ever been to a Team Canada party, know that you leave having partied hard, cheered hard, and danced to music you never imagined mixed together in the same night...



Saturday April 19 | Main Stage | 8pm

De La Soul Hailed as the future of hip-hop after their 1989 debut, 3 Feet High and Rising, De La Soul's sound blends funk, soul, reggae and psychedelic styles with clever rhymes, goofy humour, and a beloved groove that has inspired The Black Eyed Peas, Mos Def, and Camp Lo. The Grammy award winning New York based alt-rappers recently released Impossible Mission: TV Series, Pt. 1, a collection of new and some previously unreleased material.



Sunday April 20

Michael Franti and Spearhead In their only West Coast gig south of Anchorage, Michael Franti and Spearhead offer their special brand of "thinking man's hip-hop". Franti's newest album Yell Fire!, offers his most uplifting set of songs to date, inspired by a trip to war-ravaged Iraq, Israel and the Occupied Palestinian Territories. Explains Franti, "The thing that I found when I was in war zones was that nobody wants to hear songs about war. They want to hear songs about connection to people, and songs about love and life, songs that make them dance."

Freeflow A masterful blend of soul, hip-hop, reggae, funk and rock. Anything goes for these guys from Vancouver - from punk to rock, live to sample, structure to stream.

DJ DAN - His journey from the early 90s LA rave scene to his current non-stop globe trot has earned him renown and the crown "#1 DJ in the World".

DONALD GLAUDE - Alongside DJ Dan, the classically trained musician turned "Hardest Working American DJ" Donald sparked Seattle's rave scene, developing a cult following for his exuberant energy and ability to work the crowd like no one else.

MARK FARINA - Grounded in the house music of Chicago of the 1980s and Detroit Techno classics. Farina's classic record "Mood" was the first ambient house track ever made. His chunky funky rhythms and deep underground house have seen him voted in the top 20 DJs in the world by MUZIK and BPM magazine.

MAT THE ALIEN - Technically, he's not an alien, but his seamless cuts, effortless scratching and distinctive selection are otherworldly, a style that has taken him from the family record store in Bury, England, to Whistler's candle-burning scene, to a weekly fly-in gig in Vegas. He's toured the globe with crates like wormholes, sending crowds warping through other dimensions with his mind control sound.
